Sharing- Using crayons, playdough, or bubbles, introduce tum-taking and sharing. Practice repetitive vocabulary (e.g. my, me, mine, you, yours)	Use your Boom Cards to Practice: Common Toys PIN: Look on social media for PIN or text your clinician.	Drawing- Have your child draw a Valentine's family picture. Help them label each member of the family and please include any pets.	Sharing-When your child is playing on their own, ask to play with them. Practice their sharing skills. When done, help your child fill out the sharing sheet and have them color the picture.	. Snack-Offer your child part of your snack. Show them how you are sharing. You can also practice counting. Example: "one for me, one for you. two for me two for you. See, we're sharing."	Family Finger Song- On YouTube, watch <i>Family Finger</i> song. Then sing together as a family. Allow each member to sing their part. Repeat several times.	Art- On "I Love you to pieces" paper, help your child glue pieces of colored paper in the center. Practice vocabulary and colors.
. Make Valentine's Day Cards and pass them out to your family. Talk about the pictures on the cards and to whom each one is for.	Music and Movement- On YouTube, watch "Boom Chicka Boom Valentine's Day" by The Learning Station. Follow along by imitating movements. Practicing Verbs.	. Heart Stamps- Using a toilet paper roll, fold into a heart shape. Dip the heart into paint and stamp onto plain paper. practice words: dip, dip, dip, push, push, push, heart, heart, heart, more etc.	. Use your Boom Cards to Practice: B, P, M, CVC Words PIN: Look on social media for PIN or text your clinician.	. Scavenger Hunt- Using common items, help your child find something the color red, blue, yellow, green, orange, and purple.	. Fruit Loop Heart- Use a pipe cleaner to shape into a heart. Have your child string the fruit loops onto the pipe cleaner, twist the ends to close. Add a string to hang. Talk about the colors.	Valentine's Day Cookies- Decorate some Valentine's Day cookies with your child. Talk about what you need and the process.
Choose your favorite activity and do it.	Sorting- Get heart candies from your local store and sort them by colors.	. Matching- Using socks, help your child find matching socks. Point out colors, shapes or pictures on the socks. Point out "these are different, these are the same."	Painting- Cut out a heart and fold in half. Have your child paint one side, then fold the heart in half again, so the paint transfers to the other side. Open and admire their artwork.	. Choices-Throughout the day, offer your child choices. Example: "Do you want to wear the blue or red shirt today? Do you want an apple or a banana?"	Use your Boom Cards to Practice: Five Little Ducks Game PIN: Look on social media for PIN or text your clinician.	Guided Tour- Walk around your house and point out common objects. Talk about the shapes and colors. Example: "This is a clock. It's a circle, it's red."
Use your Boom Cards to Practice: Picture Scenes PIN: Look up on social media for PIN or text your clinician.	Outside Play- Engage with your child by playing "I Spy," have your child point to the object you mentioned. Guide them, if needed.	Puppet-Create a paper bag puppet. Use Pinterest, Youtube or our social media for ideas. Talk about the process and point out body parts.	. Sensory Bin-Using a bin filled with dyed rice, place smaller common toys in the bin. Have your child dig through the rice to find toys. Practice labeling.	Book- Read a book together. Holding your child's finger, label objects from each page.	Sing your child's favorite nursery song. Pause during the song to give your child the opportunity to engage with you. "Twinkle, Twinkle little."	Balloon Bug Tennis- Decorate a balloon with eyes and wings made of paper. Make 2 rackets out of paper plates and paper towel rolls. Enjoy!
