Focus on common christmas vocabulary, such as reindeer, santa, tree, lights, snowman, pjs, hat, food, etc.	Create a sorting pompom activity. Using a box, draw a xmas tree and create various holes to serve as “ornaments.” Color around the holes to show to your child which color pompom should be placed in each hole.

Focus on action verbs (e.g. cut, glue, color, etc.)	Send in a picture of your family and your christmas tree. Talk to your child about prepositions while decorating your christmas tree (e.g. under, over, next to, in, on).
