

Positive Reinforcement

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Pay attention, respond, and make positive comments and gestures to your child. Positive reinforcement is a motivation to the child after the desired behavior is exhibited, and makes the behavior more likely to happen in the future.

Positive Comments

- "Great job, you did it!"
- "Thank you for helping me clean your toys"
- "That's a great drawing!"
- "Thank you for listening!"

Positive Gestures

- Clapping and Cheering
- Giving a thumbs-up
- Giving a hug or pat on the back
- Giving a high five
